

Poppy Project #7 – Legion Memorial Housing Elevator Fund

MBNWO Legion Branches,

Provincial Command is seeking your support for a new initiative to improve accessibility for Veterans residing in Legion Memorial Housing. In 2025, your generosity helped us support 15 homeless or at-risk Veterans and secure permanent, furnished housing for eight Veterans in Legion Memorial Housing.

Poppy Project #7 aims to raise funds to replace the aging, unreliable elevator at our Kenny Street location, a permanent housing facility for Veterans in Manitoba. This upgrade is essential to ensure safe, accessible living for Veterans with mobility challenges.

The project is estimated at \$260,000–\$310,000—a significant but vital investment in the dignity and quality of life of our Veterans.

We are asking Branches across Manitoba and Northwestern Ontario to consider a Poppy Fund contribution toward this project. Donations may be made payable to RCL MBNWO Poppy Fund, with “Poppy Project #7” noted in the subject line. We are available to provide any additional details upon request.
