The Manitoba and Northwestern Ontario Command of The Royal Canadian Legion is pleased to offer scholarships to students who have demonstrated academic excellence. These scholarships will be awarded to Manitoba and Northwestern Ontario students who are continuing on to higher education.

To qualify for a scholarship a student must have his or her place of permanent residence in Manitoba or Northwestern Ontario, and be one of the following:

- (a) be a Veteran
- (b) be a child, niece, nephew, grandchild, great-grandchild, or spouse of a Veteran

Subject to the provisions for qualifications referred to above, these scholarships will be awarded to students with the highest average marks.

Important notes:

- Applications must be received at the following address no later than **4:30 P.M. July 31st**, Emails are not accepted.
- Semester graduate students may also apply.
- All questions must be answered fully, or the application will not be considered. Applicants may apply for both scholarship and bursary awards by fully completing both application forms.
